IMPORTANT NOTICE – VOLUNTEER PARTICIPATION DECLARATION

CHILD PROTECTION ACT

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RACE DAY ROLES

Please indicate your preference by writing (1) for your preferred role, (2) for your second choice and (3) for your third choice in the table below. We will endeavour to allocate you to your first preference but in some areas positions are limited.

Preferred Job – all positions are for Saturday 6th October only Please note that all job descriptions are flexible. You may be asked to assist another area on the day if additional help is required.	Approximate Times required	Please indicate preference by writing 1, 2, 3
Start Area Marshal – directing participants into the start funnel, handing out glow sticks, ensuring only registered walkers enter the start funnel. Before the race starts, walking around the site directing people to the correct area, for example, toilets, registration, start etc.	5:30pm – 9:00pm	
Course Marshal – ensuring roads are kept clear of pedestrians for your sector & directing runners in the right direction. Also assist with ensuring race route is free from cars pre-race and directing participants from the venue post-race.	5:00pm – 10:30pm	
Finish Drinks Station* – setting up of drink tables, unpacking and laying out bottled water, handing it to participants, cleaning and packing up at the end of the event.	5:00pm – 10:30pm	
Finish Chute – working quickly to move people through the finish to the finish village area.	6:00pm – 10:30pm	
Goody Bag Crew* - handing goody bags and refreshments to participants after the race, ensuring area is well presented and clean and tidy.	9:00am – 12:30pm	
Information – providing information on the event, for example, maps, toilets, start location, pre-race directions.	5:30pm – 1:00pm	
Finish Incentive Crew* – handing out “glow in the dark wristbands” to finishers. Before the race starts, walking around the site directing people to the correct area, for example, toilets, information, meeting points, etc.	6:00pm – 10:30pm	
Traffic Marshal* – monitoring and allowing access to accredited vehicles, assisting with traffic flow, ensuring cars are not parked on the course and assisting with VIP transport services.	7:30am – 12 noon	
Registration / On The Day Entries – entailing various roles, for example, assisting participants with late entries, checking forms to ensure correct information is provided, giving out the race bib numbers and timing chips, taking money for the on the day entries Note: Volunteers need to work quickly and under pressure as people always come at the last minute	5:00pm – 9:00pm
